Selected Mural Commissions:

Atlanta Botanical Gardens: Children's Garden 2017

Two murals featuring native Georgia plants and flowers, including an interactive height mural

Art on the Atlanta BeltLine: Purple Rain 2016

Design and execution of roadway underpass in conjunction with the annual Art on the Atlanta BeltLine public art exhibition. Two 80 x 24 foot walls with pylons were painted in a 42 hours, using an average of 2-3 volunteers every 6 hour day.

BBDO/Bayer: Feed-a-bee mural and short film 2016

Character design/illustration for animated/live action short and 70x40" mural commission by BBDO for Bayer's Feed-a-bee program. The Feed-a-bee initiative seeks to create forage areas with a diversity of bee-attractant plants for honey bees by distributing packs of seeds.

118'x9' mural in Historic South Atlanta commissioned by the Historic South Atlanta Neighborhood Association in coordination with the Neighborhood Arts Grants program through the Mayor's office.

South Atlanta Mural Project 2014- 2017

An ongoing series of murals in Historic South Atlanta, sponsored by the neighborhood association. This project was facilitated by a combination of city sponsored grants and private donations.
As of July 2017, 20 murals have been completed.

Sayulita Cultural Center, Sayulita Mexico 2014

Commissioned by Festival Anonymo, Bahia De Banderas
